- ❑ 60 CSU transferable units (LBCC courses numbered 1-99)
- ❑ 30 G.E. units (should be part of the 60 units above)
- ❑ Golden 4 GE Courses
 1. Area **A2** of Plan B – English Composition
 2. Area **A3** of Plan B – Critical Thinking
 3. Area **A1** of the Plan B – Speech Communications
 4. Area **B4** of the Plan B - Mathematics
- ❑ Minimum ***2.0 GPA**
(*Impacted majors may have higher GPA requirements)

UC Minimum Admissions

- ❑ 60 UC transferable units (use www.assist.org website)
- ❑ Golden 3 GE Courses in Plan C
 1. Area **1A** of the Plan C – English Composition (Eng 1)
 2. Area **1B** Plan C – Critical Thinking (Eng 3)
 3. Area **2** of Plan C – Mathematics
- ❑ Four GE Courses in two of the remaining GE areas in Plan C
- ❑ Minimum 2.4 GPA
(Competitive GPA will vary)
- ❑ Lower division courses within your major (www.assist.org) **Not required but highly recommended by UC.*
- ❑ Personal Statement **May play a role in admissions to the university.*
